Children then develop their design, thinking about special adaptations and their purpose, texture, colour and habitat. The winner will receive a model version of their design and your class wins a free Evolution workshop. This can be delivered at your school or at the Yorkshire Museum. Presentations will take place week commencing 6th July.
