45 mins

Learners will use original posers, dolly pegs, tubs and a mangle to see what doing the washing was like 100 years ago. They also have the opportunity to find out what washday smelt like, using our smelly cubes, distinguish wash day objects from the past and present and decide what the mystery washday objects were used for. This workshop can be run by a costumed character if preferred.



Castle Discoverers

45 mins

Learners can try on medieval-style helmets as well as handle original objects from the museum's collections such as pottery, arrow heads, and stained glass. For brave pupils there is a chance to try and identify various castle smells!

We also offer 30 minute tours of Kirkgate or the Prison Exhibition. These tours can be tailored to the interests of your group or to a specific subject or curriculum area.

Workshops are £45 each, tours are £30 each and are suitable for all age groups (maximum 20 students)

We also offer a sensory hamper to use on Kirkgate, our Victorian street. This can be booked free of charge, subject to availability.
